13] Environment

Coun. Mrs Brown updated the council in regard to the Bunny Hall wall and gates situation, and said she had been informed that Rushcliffe Borough Council had been engaging with the University of Nottingham estates department and had confirmed a new budget allocation had been provided for at least a five year period.

The report from Jason Mordan of Notts County Council said Rushcliffe Borough Council are looking at clearing trees which are in close proximity to the wall to prevent any further collapse and damage. They were also looking to carry out repairs centred on the gate piers, rebuilding the heads of the walls either side to about 100 yards and reinstating copings.

The meeting was told the Bunny Allotment Society were planning to mark the 75th anniversary this year of the establishment of the site and were looking to organise some sort of event.
