- 1] APOLOGIES Couns. Chris Brown, Richard Wilson, Penny Wakefield.
- 2] DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST There were none
- 3] MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING HELD ON SEPTEMBER 15, 2016 were accepted as presented and signed by the chairman
- 4] CLERK'S REPORT ON PREVIOUS MEETING BUSINESS
 Rushcliffe Borough Council was said by the clerk to be checking records as to the naming of Wysall Lane and are currently seeking views from those who might be affected. In 2002 the Borough council wrote to the parish and their letter heading was "Unauthorised boundary fence Wysall Lane Bunny" and again in 2003 stating "Land Adjacent Wysall Lane Bunny" as did Notts County Council on March 31 of that year and on June 25 and August 20 and then again on March 17 2004.
- 5] ITEMS FROM THE PUBLIC
 `No items were raised.
- 6] CORRESPONDENCE
 Notts ALC agm at Epperstone November 16 at 7-00pm. The chairman said he would attempt to attend.
 Notts County Council Supporting Local Communities Fund December 16 deadline. It was agreed an application be submitted for possible funding for a new floor in the main hall of the village hall.
 Sarah Canon village hall administrator wrote in with her resignation, necessary because of work and personal pressures. The council agreed that she had worked well on behalf of the council and agreed to make a £25 donation to her from the chairman's fund. Thanks were also given to Sarah's mother and sister for their assistance.
 Mr Dan Rhodes, Head teacher Bunny Primary School wrote a full report of use of the school play area and confirm it could be used by the public at certain times.
- 7] HIGHWAY MATTERS
 Although there had been tree cutting work carried out by the County Council nothing had been done to tackle the problems at the Gotham Lane area and the clerk was asked to write and ask again for it. There was a need for gutter cleaning work to be carried out and the clerk was to write on that as well.
- 8] COMMUNITY ROAD SAFETY GROUP, CRIME FIGURES AND NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH SCHEME
 Coun. Aldred said speed checks had been taken and there was a need for more volunteers to allow them to progress. There was a problem because more parishes were now seeking to make use of the speed checking equipment and this meant it was more difficult to have it made available in a particular village.

The chairman said the Johnsons application in respect of use of the former Brickworks site had been withdrawn before being re-heard by the County Council and it was likely a re-submission would be made.
