

Bunny and Bradmore Charities Apprentice Fee Charity - Student Grants

The Charity was set up by the Parkyns family over three hundred years ago. The aim was to support young apprentices setting out on their chosen careers. Over the centuries the number of apprenticeships having diminished greatly, the Charity Commission approved extensions to the charity's scheme to permit the Charity to make grants to students undertaking higher education courses. Each year the Charity is able to make grants to students to assist in their purchase of books or other course materials.

With 'A' level results pending and courses starting in the autumn, the Charity trustees wish to remind young persons under the age of 25 years living in the parishes of Bunny, Bradmore and Costock that one off grants are available. If you are already on a course and have not previously applied for a grant you may be eligible also. If you feel that you meet the criteria, apply in writing to the clerk to the trustees at the address below providing evidence of your acceptance onto your chosen course. Your application will be considered by the trustees at the next quarterly meeting following receipt of the application. The next meeting is early in September but if you cannot meet that time scale the application will be considered at the next available meeting.
